Visa	
Visa Application Support	International students attending DU are required to obtain a student
	visa. DU will support students in applying for a Certificate of Eligibility
	(COE), which is a preliminary step in the visa screening process to
	help make the application smoother and faster. Once the COE is
	approved, students must apply for a student visa at the Japanese
	Embassy or Consulate in their country of residence.
