

# Japanese Language Introductory Course

To take a Japanese Language Introductory Course, please read the following carefully and follow the instructions.

\*2024 spring course will be conducted Face-to-face.

\*This is an extra-curricular course. No credits provided.

## ■ Eligible

· Students who are determined as “no need to take 2024 Spring Japanese Language Placement Test” by the Japanese Level Determination Chart (See P4)

· Students whose results of the 2024 Spring Semester Japanese Placement Test were “Beginner Level” (not eligible whose Japanese Language level is I or higher)

\*This course is not for ILA students.

If you are designated to Level I or higher from your Japanese lecturer before, you should take Japanese Language Placement Test, not the Classification Test (for Introductory Course), because your Japanese level is not fit to Japanese Language Introductory Course. If you would like to learn Japanese language, please take Japanese Language Placement Test. If you don't take the test, you may not take any Japanese courses.

## ■ Classification Test (for Japanese Language Introductory Course) **\*Reservation is required.**

Students will take the tests in the order in which they arrive.

## ■ Result Notification and Application

1. Office of the Center for Global Education and Japanese Studies will let you know which class you are allocated and the course schedule to your Doshisha email account in the morning on April 16th.
2. Please see the timetable of your designated class and confirm whether or not you meet the conditions. (See P3 Important notice for Course Registration)
3. If you meet the conditions of Japanese Language Introductory Course and wish to take the course, fill in an application form and submit through MS-Forms by 9:00am April 19. The MS-Forms link will be written on the result notification email.

## Important Notice of Course Registration

1. Not eligible to register on this course if you correspond to any of the following (not eligible to submit your application):
  - Not take Classification Test (for Introductory Course) on 2024 Spring
  - Can not take every class by each timetable
  - More than 3 absence on your designated class during this semester
  - \*You may be accepted if it could be able to change your class and you can attend all classes. See below.
2. Lecturer decide to accept your registration on this course after talking with you directly, if you correspond to any of the following (You can submit your application form, but your registration will be depended on the decision of lecturer.):
  - All attendance is available if your class can be changed to another level class except for the designated one
  - More than one absence during this semester if you have no experience of Japanese learning
