## 4. Advanced Registration

1) Following subjects require "Advanced Registration". On "Advanced Registration", not every students who applied for the subjects will be registered: lots will be drawn if number of applicants exceeds capacity of the class.

- ※ Japanese Language 1-2 (Academic Writing VI-IX) [For students enrolled in or before AY2023: Japanese Language 1-2 (Written Expression VI-IX)] and Business Japanese A, B, C and D are available only for international students.
- 2) How to Apply

Apply by DUET (Doshisha University Electronic Tutorial System). For those who DUET is not available, please contact your faculty/graduate school office by Email and follow the instructions. If the number who apply exceeds the enrollment limits, registration is decided by lottery.

- 4) Result Announcement Date Friday, April 5th 0:00 (On DUET)
- 5) Notes on Advance Registration
- The University will complete the registration process for subjects requiring Advanced Registration on behalf of students. Students do not have to register for Advanced Registration subjects during the general registration period.
- ② Students can withdraw from the Advanced Registration subjects during the designated withdrawal period only. Once the withdrawal period is over, request of withdrawal will not be accepted for any reason.

Please give yourself time to consider well before applying for those subjects. In case you are successfully registered to the Fall semester's subjects during Spring semester's advanced registration, you may delete the registration during "Changing Advanced Registration Subjects" period before Fall classes begin:

③ Students taking [The Tradition and Beauty of Japan-51] or [The Tradition and Beauty of Japan-52] will be charged for flowers used in the class. The cost of flowers is 15,300 yen (Tax included) per student.

Failure to pay the fee by deadline will result in termination of registration from the subject. Please note that once paid, the fee is not refundable under any circumstances including course withdrawal.
