

[The first step to studying abroad as a science student! Let's share the charm of partner universities!]

This is an achievement report on ALL DOSHISHA Co-Learning 2018. We have reported on making an interview video with an international student and a Japanese student to introduce the appeals of partner universities, such as the reasons for applying the university, English learning, the student's daily life, and the benefits of studying abroad.

Our purpose of this project is to give engineering students opportunities to get go abroad. Based on the story I heard in the interview, I thought I would make a pamphlet made from the student's point of view. However, in order to make it easier for more people to see and access, we uploaded the video to the Doshisha web site instead of making the brochure. So, we interviewed a person who came to study at Doshisha University from a university in France and who was studying at a university in U.S. from Doshisha University. We interviewed students that is difficult to from pamphlets such as: an academic life, research, culture. We asked many things about foreign students from overseas and those who were studying abroad in order to increase the number of foreign students from Japan.

By editing the video, anyone can view it with Japanese subtitles for English voice and English subtitles for Japanese voice. The difficulty was, of course, to translate Japanese voice into English. We needed time to translate for 30 minutes on each video. We translated using only dictionary, so we had a little difficulty.

What we felt through this project was that there was a lot of information that students could only when they asked the students themselves, and that was not included in the brochure, but were worried about studying abroad, so we heard it for the first.

Therefore, in the near future, it's important to edit videos and upload them to Doshisha University's website, and eventually broadcasting them on a large screen in Doshisha.
